**ORDER OF COMMITMENT**

1. The defendant is charged with two alternative counts of first and second murder. The Court has accepted the defendant's plea of not guilty by reason of insanity to those charges.

2. Based on the State's offer of proof, the indictments, the experts' reports, and the presumption contained in RSA 651:8-b, IV, the Court finds that there is clear and convincing evidence that the defendant suffers from a mental disease or defect and that his release would create a substantial risk of harm to others.

3. Therefore, pursuant to RSA 651:8-b, IV and RSA 651:9 a, the Court orders that the defendant be committed to the secure psychiatric unit for a period of five years unless earlier discharged, released or transferred by Court order.
