28	Committee's June 18, 2019 adopted proposed cuts, from their adopted budget for the 2019-2020

32	to engage in mediation to determine the need, or lack thereof, for additional funding for the

17	detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City Council at least six (6) months prior		
18	to submitting its proposed budget for the 2020-2021 academic year; and

20	WHEREAS, the School Committee must also commit to duly adopt a Resolution to,		
21	based on the above referenced review, develop a plan of action to reduce expenditures, and will		
22	prepare a detailed report of such, which it will disseminate to the City Council at least four (4)		
23	months prior to submitting its proposed budget for the 2020-2021 academic year; and
